

## **Documentation of Notification To Property Owners Upon Which the East Ash Disposal Area is Located**

The East Ash Disposal Area CCR Unit at Tennessee Valley Authority's (TVA) Allen Fossil Plant (ALF) is located on a parcel of property owned in fee by the City of Memphis ("City") and Shelby County ("County"). TVA provides updates regarding the East Ash Disposal Area to the City, the County, the Memphis and Shelby County Port Commission ("Port"), and the Memphis Light, Gas and Water Division ("MLGW") (hereinafter collectively, "Local Entities"). During the most recent meeting on January 16, 2019, TVA provided an update to the Local Entities on the groundwater conditions at the East Ash Disposal Area.

Section 257.95(g)(2) of the CCR Rule requires the notification of persons who own or reside on land "that directly overlies any part of the plume of contamination if contaminants have migrated off-site if indicated by sampling of wells in accordance with 40 CFR 257.95(g)(1)." There is no indication of off-site migration at this time. However, TVA has provided updates to the owners of the property upon which the East Ash Disposal Area is located regarding groundwater conditions at the site. The information provided satisfies the notification requirement under the CCR Rule (40 CFR 257.95(g)(2)), to the extent applicable.
