**RE: Annual Meeting with Local Emergency Responders
Stilling Pond including Retention Pond
EPA Final Coal Combustion Residuals (CCR) Rule
TVA Cumberland Fossil Plant
Stewart County, Tennessee**

1.0 PURPOSE

This letter documents TVA's compliance with the CCR regulations at 40 CFR 257.73(a)(3)(i)(E), which requires that CUF Emergency Action Plan (EAP) include provisions for an annual face-to-face meeting or exercise between representatives of the owner or operator of the CCR unit and the local emergency responders.


2.0 ANNUAL MEETING

TVA attended a meeting on 3/15/22 with the Stewart County Emergency Management Agency to review the emergency action plan for CCR units at CUF and to discuss response strategies including internal and external response to varying levels of hypothetical emergency situations. By attending this EAP safety meeting, the requirement for conducting an annual face-to-face meeting between TVA and local emergency responders has been met and is in compliance with 40 CFR 257.73(a)(3)(i)(E).

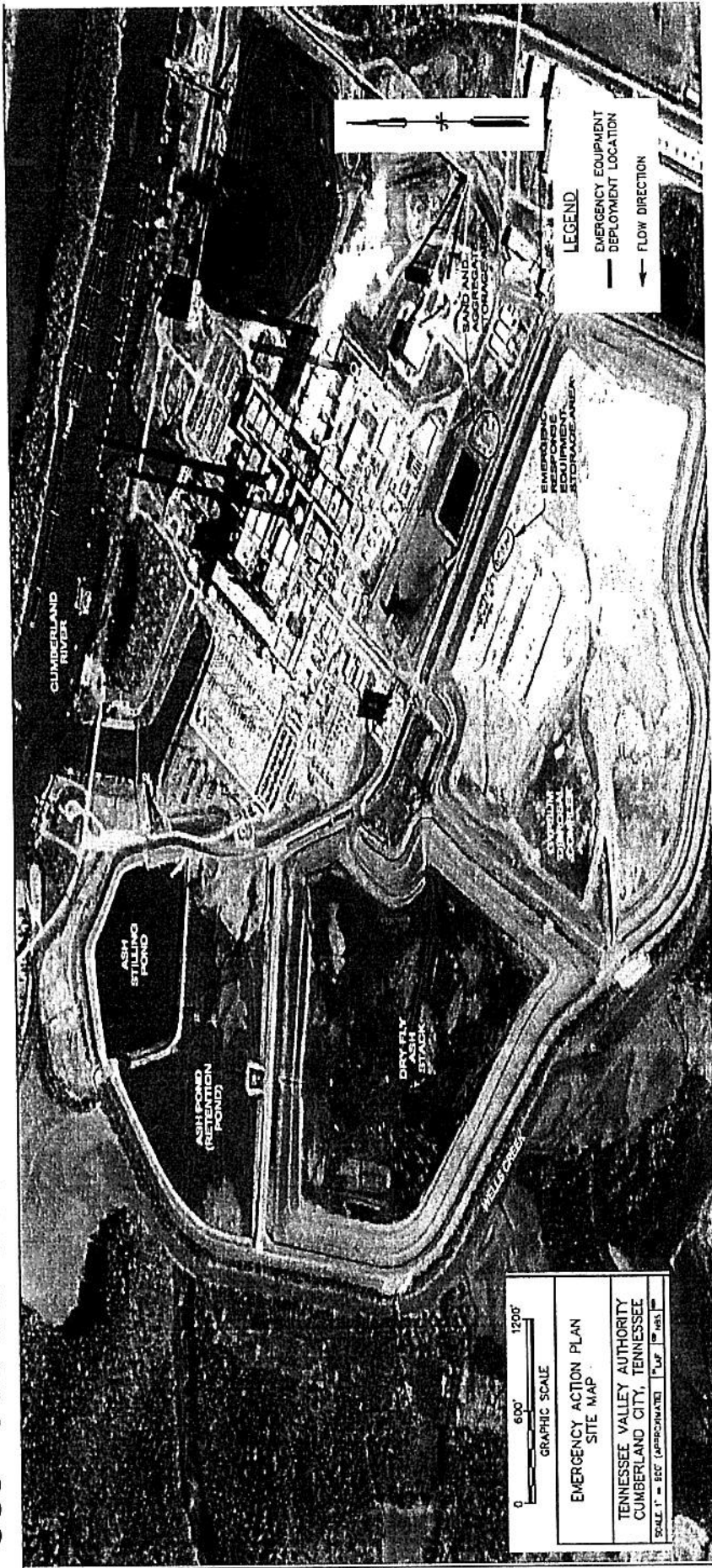
