**1.0 PURPOSE**


**2.0 ANNUAL MEETING**

By attending this EAP safety meeting, the requirement for conducting an annual face-to-face meeting between TVA and local emergency responders has been met and is in compliance with 40 CFR 257.73(a)(3)(i)(E).
