1.0 PURPOSE

This letter documents TVA's compliance with the CCR regulations at 40 CFR 257.73(a)(3)(i)(E), which requires that PAF Emergency Action Plan (EAP) include provisions for an annual face-to-face meeting or exercise between representatives of the owner or operator of the CCR unit and the local emergency responders.

2.0 ANNUAL MEETING

Due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, the annual meeting with local emergency responders to discuss the Emergency Action Plan was conducted as a Webex on 3/16/2021. TVA attended a meeting with the Muhlenberg County Emergency Management Agency to review the emergency action plan for CCR units at PAF and to discuss response strategies including internal and external response to varying levels of hypothetical emergency situations. By attending this EAP safety meeting, the requirement for conducting an annual face-to-face meeting between TVA and local emergency responders has been met and is in compliance with 40 CFR 257.73(a)(3)(i)(E).
