This document provides notice of the intent to close the Slag Ponds 2A, 2B and Slag Stilling Pond 2C (Slag Ponds) located at the Paradise Fossil Plant (PAF) as required by 40 CFR §257.102(g). As of January 12, 2021, the Tennessee Valley Authority (TVA) has ceased sending coal combustion residuals (CCR) and process water to the Slag Ponds, and the Slag Ponds are closing under the requirements of 40 CFR § 257.101(a)(1). TVA also has submitted a revised closure plan to the State of Kentucky Department of Environmental Protection on January 12, 2021. TVA has initiated closure of the Slag Ponds in accordance with the requirements of 40 CFR §257.102. In addition, TVA is providing the attached certification of the adequacy of the design of the final cover system planned for the facility as required by 40 CFR § 257.102(d)(3)(iii).
